STAFF REPORT – June 15, 2023

TO: Chair and Members of the Board of Directors

RE: Conservation Lands Strategy

Ontario Regulation 686/21 sets out the Mandatory Programs and Services which must be delivered by all Conservation Authorities in Ontario. This regulation was introduced preceding changes to the *Conservation Authorities Act* in December 2020. Section 10 of the regulation requires all Conservation Authorities to prepare a Conservation Area Strategy as a required component of the *Conservation and Management of Lands* mandatory program and service area. The creation of a Conservation Area Strategy must be completed by December 2024.

Given that the Conservation Areas Strategy must consider all lands owned by the Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority, including the Ganaraska Forest, it is in the best use of resources that the Conservation Areas Strategy process is carried out in conjunction with the Ganaraska Forest Recreational Trail Strategy, as the two documents will be complementary to each other.

As a result, the timelines proposed for Ganaraska Forest Recreational Trail Strategy will be extended into 2024.
