STAFF REPORT – November 28, 2024

TO: Chair and Members of the Ganaraska Region Source Protection Authority

RE: Proposed Amendments (Section 36 updates) to the Ganaraska Source Protection Plan and Assessment Report

On November 23, 2023 the Ganaraska Region Source Protection Authority (SPA) received information regarding the submission of the Section 36 updated Assessment and Source Water Protection Plan. Both reports were submitted to the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) in early December 2023 by the Trent Conservation Coalition Source Protection Committee.

A recent development regarding amendments proposed for the Lower Trent Region Conservation Authority Source Protection Plan has seemingly been rejected. As a result, the Section 36 Amendments for the Trent Conservation Coalition Source Protection Region have not been approved at this time. The Minister requires the LTRCA to remove the currently proposed prescribed instrument policies. A working group between the Lead Conservation Authority representative and the Ministry has been established to resolve the issue.
