The Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority has a position open for a GPS Survey Summer Student. This position also provides support functions to the watershed planning staff.

Location:

This position will be working out of the administrative office in Port Hope located at Highways 28 and 401. **Qualifications:**

- Progressing well toward a diploma from a recognized Community College or University in GIS or Civil Engineering
- A basic knowledge ESRI technologies including but not limited to ArcPro, ArcGIS Online, and ArcGIS Mobile mapping applications
- An understanding of survey techniques and global positioning systems
- Knowledge of municipal data structures and geodatabases is an asset
- Knowledge of floodplain mapping, hydrology and hydraulics is an asset
- Experience in fieldwork and problem solving is an asset
- Applicants should have excellent communication skills, both oral and written communication skills and an ability to multi-task
- The successful applicant must be able to adapt to an environment of change and work well independently as well as in a team environment
- A valid Province of Ontario drivers licence is required. There is no public transportation to the office location

Duties:

Involvement in programs of the Authority including:

- Field survey data collection using RTK GPS and Total Station
- Working with ArcGIS Online Mobile applications to collect and review GPS data
- Provide feedback to the supervisor regarding progress and any issues in the field
- Provide support and feedback to GIS team
- May require long drives to some survey sites

This is a contract position from May 2025 to August 2025. The salary for this position is \$17.70 per hour and involves a 35 hour work week from Monday to Friday 8:30-4:30 with an hour for lunch.
