Location:

This position will be working out of the administrative office in Port Hope located at Hwy 28 and 401.

Qualifications:

- Progressing well toward a diploma from a recognized Community College or University in Environmental, GIS or Civil Engineering,
- an understanding of survey techniques and global position systems,
- knowledge of municipal data structures and geodatabases is an asset,
- knowledge of flood mapping, hydrology and hydraulics is an asset,
- an understanding of ESRI technologies including but not limited to ArcGIS, ArcPro, ArcGIS Online, and ArcGIS Enterprise Server is an asset,
- experience in fieldwork and problem solving is an asset,
- applicants should have excellent communication skills, both oral and written communication skills and ability to multi-task,
- the successful applicant must be able to adapt to an environment of change and work well independently as well as in a team environment,
- a valid Province of Ontario drivers' licence is also required. There is no public transportation to the office location.
