Ganaraska Conservation, also known as the Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority (GRCA), was formed in October 1946, under the *Conservation Authorities Act*, and is one of the oldest Conservation Authorities in Ontario.

One of the nine conservation areas (CA) owned and managed by Ganaraska Conservation, Ganaraska Millennium CA is used for passive recreation, including nature appreciation, wildlife observations, picnicking, hiking, dog-walking and fishing, in season.

Ganaraska Millennium CA is adjacent to the Ganaraska River and includes the GRCA Administrative Offices. A two-kilometre, looped trail meanders around a wetland, formerly the Molson Pond, across the river from Port Hope CA.

Swimming is not permitted, while fishing is regulated through the Province of Ontario, including possession of a valid fishing license and respecting provincial catch limits. *Anglers must follow provincial fishing practices for FMZ 17.*

- CAs Open From Dawn Until Dusk.

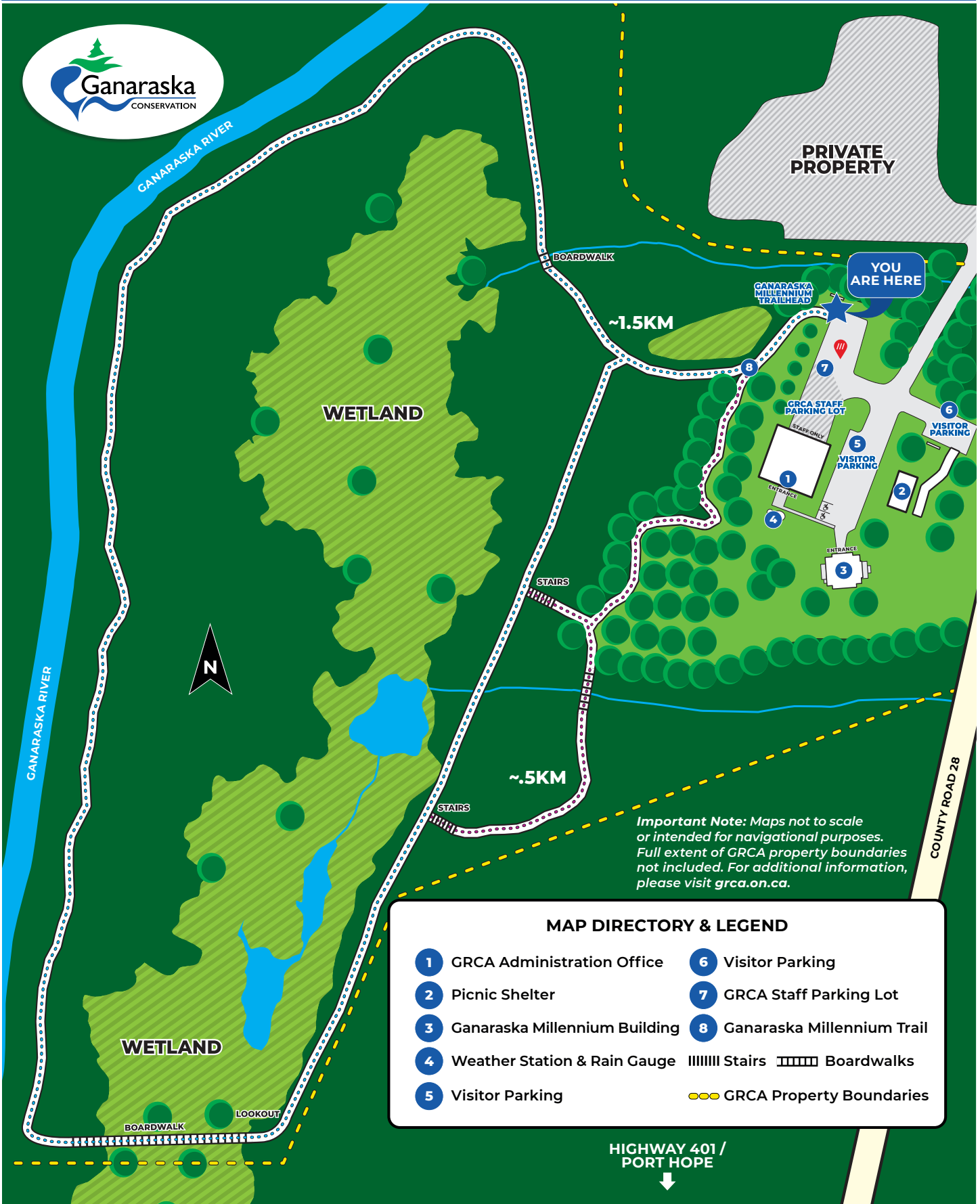
